MILESTONES

Since 1979 over seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) has been raised to plan the site and finance the capital improvements. Some of the major milestones in the development of this community asset include:

- 1913** Lodi Union High School built
Graduated classes 1913 through 1977
- 1923** Auditorium built to seat 1,180 people
- 1974** School burned – arson
- 1979** Site acquired from school district for \$475,000. Community leaders form Old Lodi Union High Site Foundation board pledge to build a community center
- 1980** First corporate donation - \$50,000 from General Mills, Inc.
- 1982** Three-acre park construction completed
- 1984** Erased total site purchase debt in December 1984, with fund raiser “The Last Night in the Girl’s Gym”
- 1986** Fine Arts Complex construction completed
- 1989** Senior Complex construction completed
- 1990** Senior Complex landscaping and irrigation completed
- 1991** Senior Patio construction completed.
- 1992** Trellis replacement
- 1993** Design development of auditorium and site completed
- 1994** North Hall Patio construction completed
- 1995** Brick plaza dedicated
- 1995** Julio Gallo Trellis dedicated
- 1996** \$10 million loan for Performing Arts and Conference Center secured from the City of Lodi
- 1998** Performing Arts and Conference Center dedicated
- 2004** Hutchins Street Square Foundation celebrates 25 successful years of supporting the Lodi community
