The paralegal can assist in: wills, power of attorney, health care directives, restraining orders, elder abuse matters, evictions, grant deeds, quick claim deeds, joint tenancy, consumer related issues and public assistance . Are you aware that these phones are FREE to eligible consumers? There is no age or income restrictions. All you have to do, if you are eligible, is fill out a simple application, (available at the senior center), have your doctor or a certified professional fill out their section, then mail it to:
